Vistamar Gran Reserva: chosen as Best Wine from Chile

In the Citadelles du Vin contest that finished a few weeks ago in Bordeaux, France, our Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah 2008 was chosen as Best Wine from Chile, taking its place as a wine of excellence at worldwide level.

This blend from the Maipo Valley was also awarded the Trophée Citadelles prize, equivalent to a Gold Medal.

This international contest was held on the 28th, 29th and 30th May and will close with an awards ceremony on 18th June in the course of Vinexpo, one of the most important wine fairs in the world.

Winemaking Concept:

"This blend, consisting of Cabernet Sauvignon (70%) and Syrah (30%), represents all our potential and experience. Each stage, from the choice of grape, the management of the vineyard and the vinification techniques used, to the ageing period in casks of different types, has been carefully and meticulously gauged to achieve high-level quality, with unique identity and personality. This blend really creates an impression, due to the balance achieved between experience, elegance and vitality".

Tasting Notes:

Colour: Dark red, of great intensity, with brilliant violet highlights.

Aroma: Ripe red and black fruits, perfectly combined with suggestions of caramel, toffee and chocolate and an interesting touch of cedar and graphite.

Flavour: A full, fruity flavour, elegant and complex, with outstandingly smooth, silky, refined tannins, and a long, persistent finish.

Match food: lamb with potatoes cooked with rosemary, silverside of pork, steak with a red wine gravy and wagyu.
