Between 26th February and 2nd March, the Vinalies International Competition was held in France with over 3,500 wines taking part from all over the world. Our **Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon / Syrah 2006**, in addition to winning a Gold Medal, was chosen as **best in the dry reds category**. We also obtained a **Silver Medal** with **Sepia Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon 2008**, which we would like to introduce to you on this occasion.

Sepia Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

Tasting Notes

Colour: black cherry with violet highlights

Aroma: ripe fruit and the classic, typical aromas of this variety such as blackcurrants, blackberries, plums and black cherries. All these are perfectly blended with the delicate, elegant aromas of a very well-integrated wood.

Flavour: tasty, with medium body and smooth, balanced tannins. Complex, full of flavours that reflect the same diversity perceived in the nose, with the black fruit and toasted notes from its ageing in barrels being predominant. An elegant and persistent finish in the mouth.

Match Food: game such as boar or venison and red meats in general.

Origin

The grapes used to produce this wine are 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Maipo Valley. In this terroir, the soils are deep loamy-clay of alluvial origin. The climate is semi-arid Mediterranean with a wide range of temperature, meaning that the grapes develop intense colour, aromas and textures as they ripen.

Winemaker's Remarks

The outstanding thing about this wine is the balance between the varietal expression of a young Cabernet Sauvignon and the spicy, toasted aromas provided by the oak. It is characterised by its strong tannins and great fruit expression.
