# SEPIA RESERVA MERLOT 2011

## TROPHY FOR RED BORDEAUX VARIETAL UNDER £15 & GOLD DECANTER WORLD WINE AWARDS



*Our Sepia Reserva Merlot 2011 has obtained the highest distinction in the Red Bordeaux Varietal under £15 class at the English competition, Decanter World Wine Awards 2013 (DWWA), being placed as the best example in the world in this category.*

### Winemaker's Comments

According to its winemaker, Irene Paiva, Sepia Reserva Merlot 2011 is an excellent representative of the Maipo, coming from deep, loamy clay soils that are alluvial in origin. In addition, the semi-arid Mediterranean climate allows the grapes to ripen perfectly, thanks to the wide temperature range. The 2010-2011 season was characterized by lower output in the red varieties, making it possible to obtain more concentrated grapes of better quality, which in turn resulted in a Merlot that is deep cherry-red in colour, with aromas of red fruits, blackberries and fresh plums, with pleasant notes of vanilla. In the mouth the predominant flavours are of ripe red and black fruits, with silken tannins and a long, pleasant finish.
